A long and flexible history

1779, 1781	Dunbar town was attacked twice during the American War of Independence.
1803-1815	The Battery was built for the Napoleonic Wars and escaped attack.
1874	→ The Battery's hospital tended to patients with infectious diseases.
1914	→ It became an Auxiliary Hospital during WW1 for wounded soldiers.
1927	Used as Emergency Housing despite being 'unsatisfactory and dangerous'.
1936	→ Roof blew off during a storm.
1937	Uninhabitable, then dismantled.
2016	→ Winter: repair-work started during storms.
2017	→ Open!
